Heartland Consumers Power District ENERGY EFFICIENCY GRANTS

Heartland energy efficiency grants may be issued to Heartland customers for energy efficiency improvements at city facilities. Grant applications will be made to Heartland and reviewed. Energy efficiency grants will not exceed \$5,000. Submitting an application is not a guarantee of funding.

*Heartland energy efficiency grants are awarded to customers for projects that will optimize electric energy use in city facilities, thereby reducing the city's energy costs. To be eligible, customers must fill out the following form and must have a specific project in mind. **Documentation outlining project costs and specifications of material being purchased must accompany application.***
